The Mid Cheshire Line Music Trains for 2019 have been announced, these will be running from April to October.

There is no charge for the Music Train, though there is a collection on the way back for the band and you will need a train ticket. At Chester you need to buy your ticket from the station ticket office or the ticket machine. At stations with ticket machines you should use those. Otherwise buy your ticket from the conductor on the train. No need to book - just get into the rear carriage.

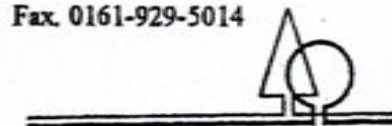
