## **Moon Partial Luna Eclipse**

This month we will see another Moon event when we will have a partial Luna eclipse on **16th July** at around 10.30pm. The Moon will be close to the horizon, so make sure you have free sight to the Southeast. During the partial phase of the eclipse, part of the Moon travels through the Earth's full 'umbral' shadow. However, on this occasion only a very small section of the Moon will be covered by the umbra at maximum eclipse, though the whole northern half of the Moon will be darkened by the penumbral shadow. The next total eclipse of the Moon is in May 2022!

## *Tornado in Ashley*

Not that sort of tornado!, but the famous new-build steam locomotive, was on the Mid Cheshire Line on Sunday, 11<sup>th</sup> May, it passed through Ashley at around 5pm. Unfortunately we did not have enough notice to alert you about this train passing through the village, so you'll have to save your flag waving until the next time it passes through Ashley.

## *Mid Cheshire Line Music Trains*

There is no charge for the Music Train, though there is a collection on the way back for the band and you will need a train ticket. At Chester you need to buy your ticket from the station ticket office or the ticket machine. At stations with ticket machines you should use those. Otherwise buy your ticket from the conductor on the train. No need to book – just get into the rear carriage.

**Music trains from Chester** - Music Train leaves Chester at 19:01 and return leaves Plumley for Chester at 22:29.

**Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> August** – to the Golden Pheasant, Plumley with Terry Burgin Blues Band.
