RESIDENT COMMENTS:

1. Hough Green

Residents expressed concern that the green was being used as a dog toilet because it was regularly used by young children as a play area. In one case it appeared that the dog owner was intentionally taking the dog to the green for toilet purposes.

Another dog escapes from its owner's garden on occasion and it too fouls the green. Unfortunately the fence surrounding the garden is broken in parts and offers to mend the fence on behalf of the resident have not been taken up.

2. Parking on Cow Lane

A van is regularly parked at the junction of Cow Lane and Hough Green. It makes exiting Hough Green quite hazardous as it is impossible to see oncoming traffic without moving out into Cow Lane. Although it is a 30mph zone, cars frequently exceed the speed limit and it is only a matter of time before an accident occurs.

The Chairman acknowledged the comments and explained that both these matters were on the Agenda for the Council meeting immediately following this meeting. The Council will give the problems its full attention.
